Indoor moisture and damp cellars lead to condensation and cause excessive black mold growth.



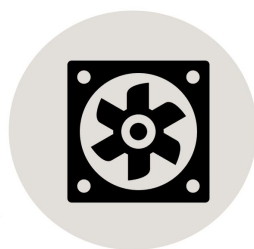
Flooding that humidifies space
